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The report observes the ongoing transformation process of the European party system and political landscape. The authors present factors which influence the ideological evolution of political organisations in the main EU states. The role of new parties, unconventional for the European political landscape is also analyzed here. The authors undertake a forecast of possible future development of the EU in the context of growing Eurosceptic sentiment.

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regional system of international relations, basing on it some of the recent White House's practical policy decisions. Under these circumstances, the ballistic missile defense system – a pillar of the American military and strategic dominance – may be subjected to significant change. This system's tasks are nowadays defined not only by the necessity of the U.S. territory protection from a possible Russia's strike, but also from China's growing military might as well as from a recently gained North Korea's ballistic potential. Moreover, the regional BMD component's importance has grown recently due to necessity for fulfillment of the U.S. allied obligations as well as desire for altering the regional power balance in Washington's favor.

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
